## **The Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin**

### **By-Law No. 2023-20**

#### **A By-law to Authorize the Execution of the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Safe Restart Agreement Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funding between His Majesty the King in Right in Ontario represented by the Minister of Transportation and the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin**

**Whereas** Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority; and

**Whereas** it is deemed expedient that The Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin enters into an Agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the purposes of a Transfer Payment Agreement for the Safe Restart Agreement Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funding; and

**Now Therefore** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin enacts as follows:

1. That the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin hereby authorizes the agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation, in the form of an agreement titled the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Safe Restart Agreement Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funding ("Agreement"), identified as Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming an integral part of this By-law.
2. That the Mayor and CAO/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to execute such agreement and any related documents and affix the Seal of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin thereto.
3. That the Mayor and CAO/Treasurer have the delegation of authority to execute any and all required documentation, on behalf of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin, as required under the Safe Restart Phase 4 Municipal Transit program.
4. That the Municipality of West Elgin commits to spending the Safe Restart Phase 4 Municipal Transit funding in accordance with all of the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement.

5. This by-law shall come into force and effect on March 09, 2023.

Read a first, second, and third time and finally passed this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 2023.
