Fleming 225th anniversary events/exhibit/program to be held in 2022 requires staff time for research, finding and contacting living descendants, grant writing, planning and meetings with the organizing committee. This is outside of the normal activities staff does on a yearly basis. As these were the first settlers in historic Aldborough Township (and Elgin County) we are requesting support from council.

It is anticipated that approximately 4 hours/week during 2021 will be needed to prepare for this commemoration while also continuing to tell the story of the Municipality of West Elgin through tours and exhibits on a daily basis in the house museum and new Agricultural Centre.

Backus-Page House Museum is operated by the Tyrconnell Heritage Society, situated in picturesque John E. Pearce Provincial Park, just south of Wallacetown, Ontario. We are in the heart of the Talbot Settlement, on the shores of Lake Erie. Enjoy the Spicer Trail, Storey Wetlands Trail, heritage gardens, historic barn, outbuildings, 1850's Georgian style house museum and coming soon our Agricultural History Centre. Discover period room settings that tell the story of the Backus family and changing exhibits showcasing the rural communities of Dutton Dunwich and West Elgin.

The Ministry of Natural Resources (Ontario Parks) currently retains ownership of the Backus-Page House. The Ministry entered into a lease agreement with the Tyrconnell Heritage Society. The society was incorporated in 1994 with the express purpose of restoring the house and property to its 1850's condition. In 1998 the society undertook a restoration of the property, renamed the house in tribute to both its longtime owners and undertook a mandate of preservation and historical education regarding the estate and the Talbot Settlement in general. 
