This letter will acknowledge receipt of correspondence dated December 2^{nd} , 2021, over the signature of the West Elgin Clerk in which Council identifies certain complaints received from the public regarding the ongoing work undertaken by PGYC at the Port Glasgow Public Beach as well as communication concerns and damage done to the public foot bridge.

The PGYC Board of Directors discussed this matter at length during our monthly Board of Directors meeting, December 14th, 2021. Directors individually and collective expressed their dismay that this initiative undertaken in support of and to enhance the Port Glasgow community had been called into question. Directors voted unanimously to conduct a detailed review of all aspects of this ongoing initiative from its inception in the winter of 2021 with a focus on initial planning, consultation, communication, and work undertaken and completed to date and finally next steps moving to completion.

It is anticipated that PGYC will be able to provide Council findings of our review along with the results of consultations with the Lower Thames Valley Conservation authority regarding project completion towards the end of January 2022.
